Years 3 to 6 Clubs & Activities

Beavers (Ages 6 - 8)

Beavers is part of the Scouts organisation and is open to girls and boys aged between 6 and 8 years of age. The aim of Beavers is to teach a host of new skills to all children while maintaining a theme of adventure and fun.

Cubs (Ages 8 - 10)

Cubs is part of the Scouts organisation and is open to girls and boys aged between 8 and 10 years of age. For Cubs, excitement and adventure are key. The Cubs programme offers a huge variety of activities surrounding areas of fitness, global and beliefs; whilst allowing them to be creative.

Prep Orchestra (Years 3 to 6)

Prep Orchestra is open to children in Years 4, 5 & 6 who play an orchestral instrument. Rehearsals take place after school until 5pm every Thursday during term time. These rehearsals will be in Year group bubbles, for the time being, in the Rehearsal Studio, Chapel and Prep Hall. The children learn to play a variety of genres of music and (hopefully) will perform in a Christmas Concert and a Summer Concert.

Year 3 Lego and Hama Beads Club

Welcome to a world of creation through Lego and Hama Beads. Children will create models each week in WB2.

Year 3 Needlecraft

Learning simple stiches to create a sampler bookmark, nothing too complicated, perfect for beginners.

Year 4 Drama Club

Each week will begin with a variety of warm-up games. The main part of the session will then be based around a specific stimuli, for example a piece of poetry or short story. Pupils will work in groups to bring their written piece of work to life and will perform it to the rest of the group.

Years 3, 4 and 5 Football Club

Run at lunchtime and consisting of fitness, drills and game related practices and small-sided matches. Open to all abilities.

Years 3 to 6 Clubs & Activities

Year 4 Board Games & Construction Year 4 Board Games and Construction Club will offer the children the opportunity to play a mixture of traditional and modern board games. In addition to this, the children will be able to choose a

traditional and modern board games. In addition to this, the children will be able to choose a construction activity using kits such as Kinex and Meccano. The main emphasis of the club will be on having fun, but the children will also develop strategic thinking, communication skills and the ability to work as part of a team.

Year 4 Netball Club / Years 5 / 6 Netball Club

Netball clubs will run throughout the Michaelmas and Lent terms. The sessions will include skill-based drills and will generally finish with a match, allowing pupils to put skills gained into action.

Years 5 Rugby Club Year 5 Rugby Club will run throughout the Michaelmas and Lent terms and takes place on the main

school field. The club aims to introduce the core skills of the game. Each session will start with handling drills, before the focus moves to a specific area. Sessions often conclude with a small-sided match, which enables the pupils to put skills learnt into match situations.

Year 5 Climbing Club

An indoor climbing club that runs at our climbing wall in the Sports Hall. It is for climbers of all abilities, from complete beginners to children that enjoy climbing out of school. Children will boulder, climb up and abseil down our many different routes. They will learn and practise new techniques in a safe and fun environment.

Year 5 Aspiring Leaders

An exciting addition to this year's co-curricular programme focusing on developing core leadership skills through a series of enjoyable and engaging practical activities.

Years 3 to 6 Clubs & Activities

Year 6 Football Club

Run on a Tuesday morning and consisting of fitness, drills and game related practices and small-sided matches. Open to all abilities.

Year 6 Badminton and Table Tennis Club

Run on Wednesdays from 4pm to 5pm in the Senior School Sports Hall, Year 6 Badminton and Table Tennis club will run throughout the Michaelmas Term. The first half of sessions will concentrate on learning the game and the associated rules together with competitions in both singles and doubles. The second half will focus on a ladder style competition. PE kit should be worn. All equipment will be provided by School if necessary.

Year 6 Rugby Club

Year 6 Rugby Club aims to build upon the core skills introduced in Years 4 and 5. A typical session starts with ball handling drills, before the focus moves to a specific area of the game, where pupils look to gain a deeper understanding. Sessions often conclude with a small-sided match, which enables the pupils to put the session focus into action.
